- 2. What is the view of women contained in #'s 488-489? Is it positive or negative?
- 3. The dogma of the Immaculate Conception teaches that Mary did not need a savior. True or False? Why? (#'s 490-493)
- 4. Who are the "brothers and sisters of Jesus" spoken of in the New Testament? (# 500)
- 5. St. Augustine is quoted at the end of # 506. Discuss this statement in your sharing group.
- 6. "Love your mother" (referring to planet earth) is a slogan used by contemporary environmentalists. For Christians, this expression has 3 possible meanings (planet earth not being one of them!) What are they? (# 507)
- 7. Without faith, is it possible to fully appreciate the Gospels? (# 515)
- 8. In # 526 we read, "To become a child in relation to God is the condition for entering the kingdom." Explain this statement.
- 9. What are some of the important ways in which Jesus is to be "our model?" (# 520)
- 10. How does the "finding of Jesus in the temple" reveal our Lord's "total consecration to a mission that flowed from his divine sonship?" (# 534)
